ANNUAL REPORT

Dear Partners,

Thank you for your prayers and financial support to KCM.

The 17th Parliamentary election in India was held in seven phases from 11 April to 19 May 2019. The BJP (Bharathiya Janatha Party) won 303 seats and together with their allies have 2/3rd majority in the parliament. The opposition is weak and divided.

This is good because the government can propose bills and enact laws with confidence and lead the country boldly. This also can be misused and cause unrest among the religious minorities in India including the Christians.

The recent Citizenship Amendment Act, 2019 passed by the Parliament of India on 11 December 2019 has caused much agitation all across the country.

In general, religious minorities including Christians foresee amendment to the constitution of India declaring India to be a “HINDU” State based on HINDUTHUWA.

(The core concept of Hinduism is leading a meaning-full life whereas that of Hindutva is hegemony of Hindu beliefs and practices. Hinduism guides people towards Moksha, whereas Hindutva guides people to acquire political power. Hinduism is a religious belief, but Hindutva is a political movement.)

At present, India is a secular state. People belonging to all religions are treated equally and every citizen has the freedom to believe, practice and propagate his/her religion without discrimination.

As far as we are concerned, we believe that almighty God is in control of everything that happens in this world and He will not let anything happen that does not work out for the good of those who love him.

As of now we have the freedom to preach and teach our faith while foreign contributions cannot be used for conversion. In fact, we have never used foreign contributions for conversions. Genuine conversions are a result of convictions based on the teachings one receives using freedom of choice.

We were able to start two congregations in Odisha using Indian funds raised by the Kerala Congregations in 2019. Another new congregation was established in Andhra and thus 3 new congregations in 2019. This makes the total number of Congregations 73 since 1978.

All the congregations in KERALA are self-supported and they continue to support the preachers in Odisha.

The Kerala Congregations also support a “Translation Ministry” and in 2019 The New Testament was translated and published in the Jaunsari Language of UTHARAGHANT. The work continues with the translation of the Old Testament.

Our Hospital serves to provide patient care to an average of 80 patients per day in addition to the expertise in Medical Diagnostics. Medical and Surgical Camps are conducted regularly in addition to awareness programmes. The Senior Home for women is a refuge for neglected senior persons where service with a smile is provided irrespective of their socio-economic status.

KCM preachers are given on-job training on a regular basis by our qualified leadership and occasionally outside experts are used to update on socio-legal matters. We make sure that they are well equipped spiritually and academically.

The Serenity Counselling Centre has saved several marriages and our Child development programs and Youth programs are designed to bring up the next generation in the way of TRUTH.

The Kingdom of God continues to expand beyond the boundaries of INDIA as the congregations in DUBAI, DOHA and NEW YORK ministers to the brethren in those areas giving glory to God.

We thank you for your faithful support to this ministry that aims at preparing souls for eternity while caring for their needs now and here, out of love exemplified by JESUS.

## YOUTH WELFARE

Martin Joseph has a dedicated team of young preachers to lead a well-organized youth program with the advice and support of the senior preachers of KCM. They meet periodically and work out an year plan to participate the youth and train them to be future leaders of the Church.

A soccer team was formed to develop discipline and unity among the youth in Kottayam area churches. Every Sunday evening 4.00 PM to 7.00 PM around 20 youth gather from area churches in KCM play ground. They pray, have Bible study, play together and have fellowship.

## CHILD DEVELOPMENT

The new curriculum developed by KCM preachers under the leadership of CINDY MARTIN is being used widely and the same also helps as a resource for Bible Study groups. VBS was conducted in 14 churches with the theme "LIGHT HOUSE", approximate 950 children and 70 volunteers participated. Dr. Keri and team's visit in March provided an opportunity for 200 children to take part in VBS from the Churches in Vagamon area.

Serenity Counselling Center conducted seminars in Angamaly for Ernakulam area churches in August on "Conflict Resolution."



## HOSPITAL MINISTRIES

Abey Thomas Manages the daily activities of CMC Hospital caring for the out patients and in-patients.

Martin Joseph does the administrative work in addition to the KCM administration.

With the help of a dedicated team of doctors and staff C.M.C Hospital is serving the needy with the love of Christ.

Our oncology department gives hope to many cancer patients and also opens door for ministry to terminal patients.

The C.M.C diagnostic department continues to help several hospitals and clinics in the state with expert diagnosis through our well-equipped modern Clinical Laboratory, Ultrasound Units, Endoscopic Units and Special Digital X-ray and Mammography Units.

Our Surgical department is used by several freelancing surgeons with laparoscopic equipment.

TEAM FROM McDonough Christian Church visited us and participated in several medical camps.

Cancer detection camp and Eye Camp were well attended and many were blessed. The presence of the Union Minister for State for Culture and Tourism for the camp was an added privilege.

The team of 6 was led by Diana Cliatt and they were, Ellen & Clifford Fleming, Elizabeth, Olasupo and Antonio.

We continue to conduct awareness camps about cancer, and on a monthly basis we conduct “Fibro-scan” camps to detect liver function free of cost to 50 patients. We are praying for a modern Ultrasound Scan unit that could detect liver cancer in early stages. The Lord is already providing for that.



## TRANSLATION MINISTRY.

Kerala Churches support the translator “Mathews John” a native of Kerala who is now living in Utharagant with his family.

He works in collaboration with Wycliff India and has completed the translation of the New Testament into JAUNSARI, the language of the JAUNSARI TRIBE of Northern India. The New Testament was released and dedicated on 30 November, 2019. There was a two day seminar on 28 & 29 for the JAUNSARI CHRISTIANS. They are working on the Old Testament translation currently.
